

Skip-A-Pay Program

To help with holiday expenses and taxes, eligible Credit Union members may be able to skip the December payment on their loans. To be eligible, a loan must have been opened prior to June 1, 2021, had a full payment made within 45 days and there may be no more than two 30-day delinquencies. Any loan that has been refinanced is considered a new loan and is subject to the above guidelines. If you are interested in the skip-a-pay option, please talk to a member services representative. Forms will be available in the office the end of October!

To better assist our members with daily purchases and ATM transactions, we have increased the daily dollar limit on Horizon Credit Union debit cards. The daily dollar limit for point of purchase transactions has been increased to \$2,500 and for ATM transactions, the limit has been increased to \$500. Inactive Accounts

An inactive account is any account with a balance of less than \$100.00 of which there has been no activity of any kind for a period of 12 months. Dividends posting to the account do not count as activity. When an account becomes inactive, the account will be assessed an inactive account fee of \$5.00 for every quarter the account remains inactive. Inactive account fees will not be charged to accounts where the member is less than 18 years old in age. All you need to do is make a minimal deposit to trigger your account to an active account status. Please call the office with any questions that you may have about your account.

If you think that you may have misplaced your Horizon Credit Union debit card, you can now log in to your online account and turn it off. Simply log back in and turn the card back on once you have located it.
